T. Baker, was the pastor of the local Baptist Church; therefore, he took her to church often and for most occasions. So church was her rock in a weary land. Mrs. Britt graduated from Peck High in 1954 and went to FAMU. Graduated from FAMU in 1958 and began her career in Highlands County. Her first salary in Sebring, FL as a School Librarian was \$3,500 for the year. Surely, times were tough then. She met her late husband, Robert L. Britt, in Highlands County and they were married in 1959. Two Sons were born to this union, Robert L. Britt, Jr. and Kerry K. Britt. She earned a Master's degree in Education from the University of South Florida in Tampa, FL. Mrs. Britt retired from Highlands County as an Assistant Principal when her husband became deathly ill. Later she moved to Williamsburg, Virginia. In Williamsburg is where she worked diligently in the Church and began her mission with Ministry. Williamsburg became her Mt. Olivet where she prayed, read and studied the Bible intently.

After Williamsburg, she moved to Charlotte, North Carolina. During her stay in a North Carolina, she began working at the college level. In 1998, Mrs. Britt returned to Florida and worked at Lake City Community College and Edward Waters College. Yulee is still home; she joined First Baptist Church of Yulee and remained there until death. Mrs. Britt is the author the book entitled, Get Off That Pew And Find Something To Do! She developed the Inspirational Key Chain concept to share with others in lifting Jesus a little higher and she did ten years with the Jail and Prison Ministry in Duval County. Later in life she learned that the JOY of the Lord was her strength and that serving God will pay off tremendously.
