Larry James Jennings arrived on October 13, 1948 in Donaldsonville, Georgia as the first child to Leo and Emma Jennings. Larry graduated from Union Grove High School in 1966 and attended Chipola Junior College from 1966-1968. He married Hazel Jennings on February 28, 2004; and the mother of his daughters, Isabella Rios Davis; and mother of his son, Doris Curtis.

Larry lived his life with adventure, a thirst for knowledge and constant social interaction. He was passionate about luxury automobiles and music, often sharing it with others. He explored 43 States across America as a sales representative. While in Miami, he worked for the “Godfather of Soul, James Brown”. He also worked as a disc jockey in New York, Savannah, Georgia and Marianna, Florida. Larry drove limousines for Twin Luxury Limousine in Jacksonville, Florida. He could pick a “hit tune” long before it topped the charts. Whether DJ-ing his on-line radio station or transporting clients, music always filled his life.
