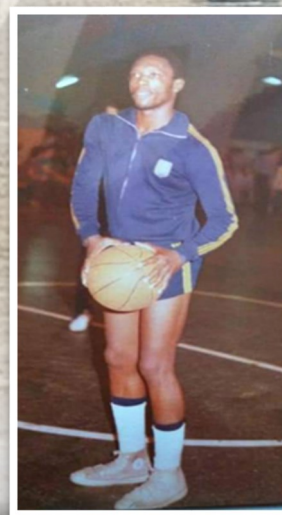
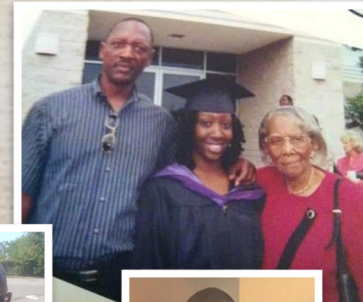
"Coach"
