## *Obituary*

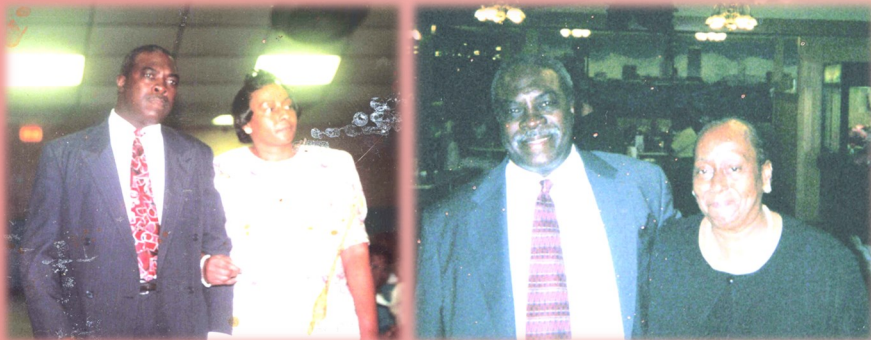
