Christopher Antwan Cannon was born in Jacksonville, FL on January 14, 1984 to his parents, Will Nichols and Diane Cannon Nichols.

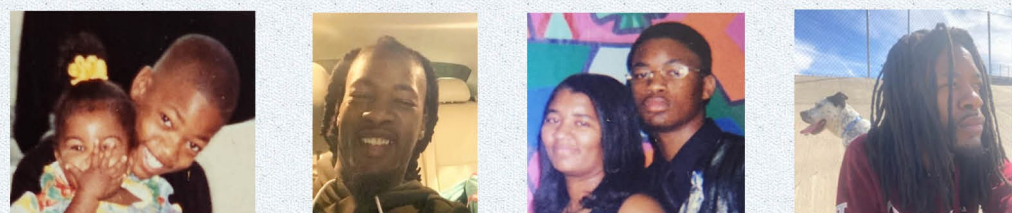
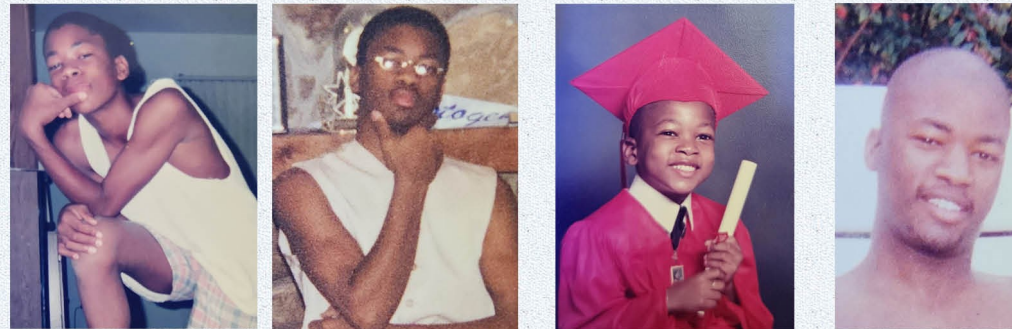
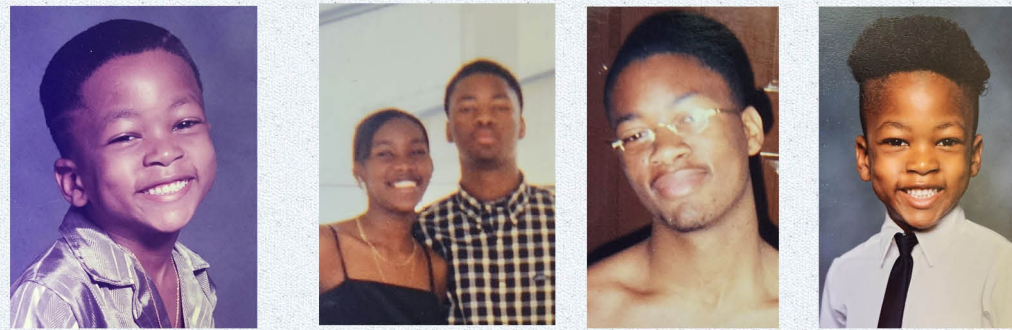
Chris confessed Christ at an early age of 10 years old. He was baptized at Northside Church of Christ.
